Summary

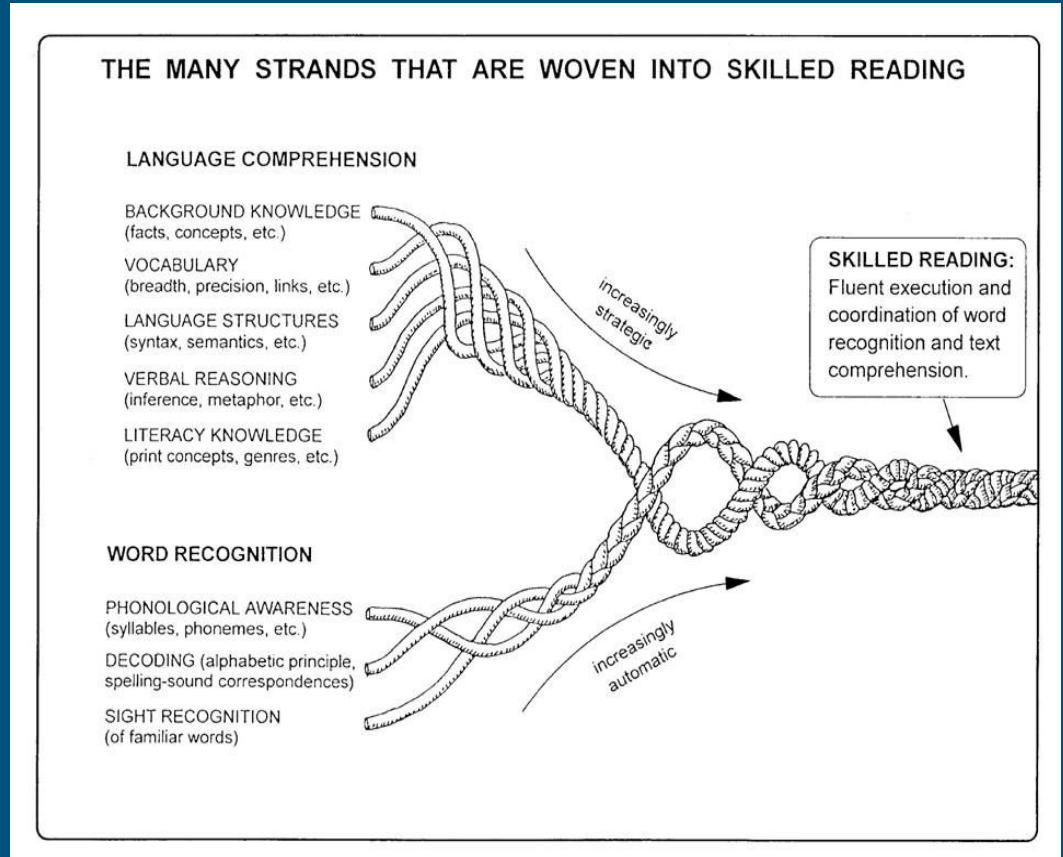


- Designed to expose children to a high volume of full-length, deeply engaging trade books to build knowledge and drive literacy instruction
- Each book provides new content within predictable and consistent instructional routines
- Each day, students:
 - read (or are read to), as well as analyze and discuss interesting authentic texts representing diverse authors, characters, and topics
 - complete writing assignments that reinforce comprehension and build writing skills
 - hear, read, and speak a high volume of words, helping to build a rich vocabulary
 - build a deep appreciation of books and learning

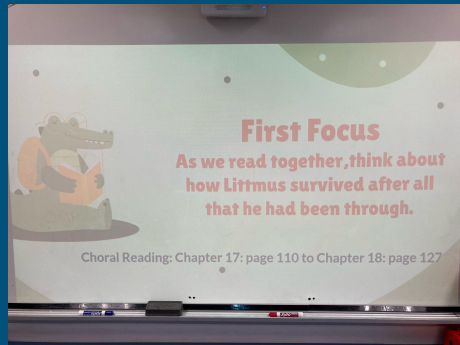

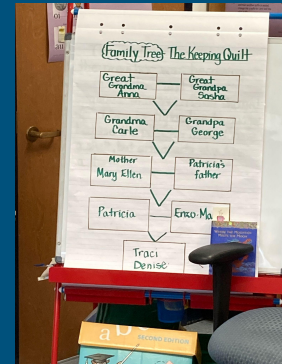


ELA Block

Skills Block

- Phonemic Awareness
- Foundations
- Skills group: decodables



Word Study that focuses on generalizing rather than memorizing:

- 5 day sequences - 2 words per day
- Building sentences (K - 2nd)
- Super Sentences (3rd and up)
- Transfer words on assessments

Explicit vocabulary instruction:

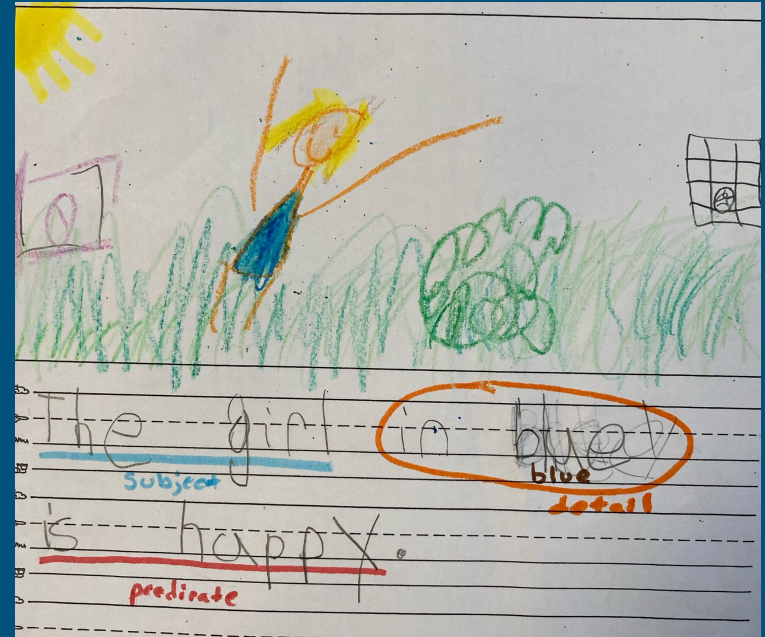
- Presented in context of text

Built-in Assessments

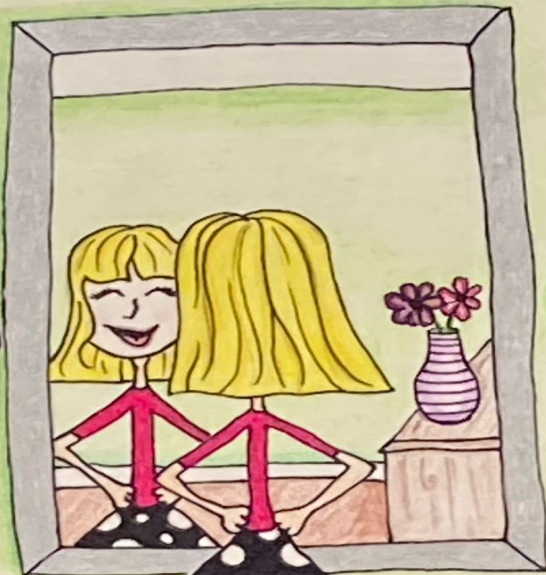
Area	Grade Level	Frequency
Retellings	K	Every 5 days
Text Connections	K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd	4x per module
Speaking & Listening	K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd	1x per month
Word Study Assessments	K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd	Every 5 days
Narrative Writing	1st, 2nd, 3rd	1x per module
Informational Writing	1st, 2nd, 3rd	1x per module
Opinion Writing	1st, 2nd, 3rd	
Editing	1st, 2nd, 3rd	1x module
Culminating Task - Content Knowledge, Literacy Knowledge, and Integration of Knowledge and Ideas	K, 1st, 2nd, 3rd	1x module

Culminating Task - 4 per year (end of module)

- **Showcases** knowledge of the specific genre of writing, specific text structure, and content learned
- **Requires** listening, speaking, reading and writing
- **Demonstrates** content knowledge, literacy knowledge and integration of knowledge
